RoHS Directive 2015/863 (RoHS 3) Statement

US Digital is committed to compliance with RoHS regulatory requirements, including RoHS 3, or Directive 2015/863, which adds 4 phthalates to RoHS 2 Directive 2011/65/EU. The addition of 4 new substances to RoHS restriction list includes phthalates DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP.

The updated list of restricted substances referred to in Article 4(1) and maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials:

- Lead (0,1 %)
- Mercury (0,1 %)
- Cadmium (0,01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0,1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0,1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0,1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0,1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0,1 %)

US Digital is aware of the required implementation date of July 22, 2019 and we have already begun the process of working with our suppliers to ensure compliance with the new directive by required date.

US Digital will provide notification to customers, as well as have it posted on our website when the process is completed.
